April 8, 2004: Blayne once again advises Mr. Grimmer that any contract must be approved by the Council prior to Mr. Grimmer signing a contract. Mr. MIncey confronts Mr. Grimmer about notifying Lewis Mohr that he would no longer be agent of record for the insurance without Council approval. During this discussion, Mr. Honeycutt advises Mr. Grimmer that any contract for projects, equipment, professional services or materials and supplies must be approved by the Council.

October 11, 2005: Again, a contract is renewed by the Parish President without consent of the Council. The agenda had to be lifted for the Council to again authorize a contract signature by the Parish President after the fact.

In spite of repeated reminders, this trend has continued to this day since no contract can be produced for Forte & Tablada and no contract for services has been approved for Faulk & Winkler who continue to perform financial work for the Parish.

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
